**SCHEME OF POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIPS TO THE
OTHER BACKWARD CLASSES FOR STUDIES IN INDIA**

1. OBJECTIVE :

The Government of India has since independence initiated a number of steps for improving the level of literacy and education. In this context, the Government has recognized that educational and economic support for backward classes, has not been adequate and that there is disparity between them and the non-backward sections of the population at every level. It is self-evident and universally accepted that education is one of the key instruments of effective development of weaker sections.

Based on the recommendations of the Working Group on Development and Welfare of Backward Classes, it is proposed to launch a new Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post-Matric Scholarship for Other Backward Classes (OBCs) students.

The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the OBCs students studying at post matriculation or post secondary stage to enable them to complete their education.

II. SCOPE :

These scholarships shall be available for studies in India only and will be awarded by the Government of State/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs, i.e. permanently settled. 100% central assistance will be provided to State Governments/UT Administrations for this purpose.

III. CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY:

- i) The scholarships will be open to India nationals belonging to OBCs as notified by the Central Govt./State Govt. UT Admn.;
- ii) These scholarships will be given for the study of all recognized post-matriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in recognized institutions with the following exceptions:
"Scholarships shall not be awarded for training courses like Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Course and Private Pilot License Courses, Courses at Training-Ship Duffer in (Now INS Rejendra), course of training at the Military College, Dehradun, courses at Pre-examination Training Centres of All India and State levels and Trade Courses at the Industrial Training Institutes."
- iii) Only those candidates who belong to OBCs so specified in relation to the State/UT to which the applicant actually belongs, i.e. permanently settled and who have passed the Matriculation or Higher secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education will be eligible.
- iv) Candidates who after passing one stage of education are studying in the same stage of education in different subject e.g. I. SC after I.A or B.Com after B.A. or M.A. in a subject after M.A in another subject will not be eligible.
- v) Students who, after having completed their educational career in one professional line, e.g., LLB after B.T/B. Ed will not be eligible.
- vi) Students studying in Class of the Higher Secondary School courses or the XII class of the Multipurpose High School not be eligible for it being a continuous school courses. However, in cases, where tenth class examination of such courses is treated as equivalent to Matriculation and students who after passing tenth class join other courses, such students will be treated as post-matric students and will be eligible for the award of scholarships.
- vii) Students pursuing Post-graduate courses in medicine will be eligible if they are not allowed to practice during the period of their course.
- viii) Students who after failing or passing the Under Graduate/Post-Graduate examinations in Arts/science/ Commerce join any recognized professional or Technical certificate/diploma/degree courses will be awarded scholarships if

- otherwise eligible. No subsequent failure will be condoned except courses in Group 'A' and no further change in the course will be allowed.
- ix) Students who pursue their studies through correspondence courses will be eligible towards reimbursement of non-refundable fee. The term correspondence includes distant and continuing education. Besides reimbursement of non-refundable fee, such students will also be eligible for an annual allowance of Rs. 500/- for essential /prescribed books, as applicable.
 - x) Employed students whose income combined with the income of their parents/guardians does not exceed Rs. 44,500/- per annum shall be eligible for post-matric scholarships to the extent of reimbursement of all compulsorily payable non-refundable fees. *
 - xi) Only two children of the same parents/guardian will be entitled to receive scholarships. This restriction will, however, not apply to girls. Accordingly, scholarship availed by girls of same parents/guardian will not adversely affect admissibility of availing scholarship upto two boys of same parents/guardian.
 - xii) A scholarship holder under this Scheme will not hold any other scholarship /stipend. If awarded any other scholarship/stipend, the students can exercise his/her option for either of the two scholarships/stipends, whichever is more beneficial to him/her and should inform the awarding authority through the Head of the Institution about the option made. No scholarship will be paid to the students under this Scheme from the date he/she accepts an other scholarships/stipend. The student can however, accept free lodging or a grant or ad-hoc monetary help from the State Government or any other source for the purchase of books, equipment or for meeting the expenses on board and lodging to the scholarship amount paid under this Scheme.
 - xiii) Students who have already received coaching in any of the pre-examination training centers with financial assistance from the Government will not be eligible.
 - xiv) In case of unemployed students whose parents/guardians income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 44,500 per annum will be entitled for the scholarship under the Scheme.

Note 1: So long as either of the parents (or husband in the case of married unemployed girl students) are alive, only income of the parents/husband, as the case may be, from all sources has to be taken into account and of no other members even though they may be earning. In the form of income declaration, income is to be declared on this basis. Only in the case where both the parents (or husband in the case of married but unemployed girl student) have died, the income of the guardian who is supporting the student in his/her studies has to be taken into consideration. Such students whose parent's income is affected due to unfortunate death of one of earning parents and resultanty comes within the income ceiling prescribed under the scheme, shall become eligible for scholarship, subject to their fulfilling other conditions of eligibility, from the month in which such sad incidence takes place. Applications for scholarships from such students can be considered even after lapse of last date of receipt of applications, on compassionate grounds.

Note 2: House Rent Allowance received by the parents of a student be exempted from the computation of 'income' if the same has been permitted to be exempted for purpose of Income-Tax.

Note 3: Income Certificate is required to be taken once only, i.e. at the time of admission to courses which are continuing for more than one year.

IV VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP:

The value of scholarship will include maintenance allowance, reader charges for blind students, reimbursement of compulsory non-refundable fees. Study Tour Charges, thesis typing/printing charges and book allowance for students pursuing correspondence course for complete duration of the course. The details are given below:-

Note: 1 Commercial Pilot License Course(CPL)

CPL course shall be covered under Group 'B'. The number of awards for CPL will be 20 per annum. Consequent upon receiving applications from concerned students, concerned State Governments/UT Adms., should scrutinize them for determining their eligibility under the Scheme and thereafter intimate the number of eligible applications for CPL training (with their names) for each financial year to Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment (the applications themselves need not be sent to the Ministry). Upon receipt of such information, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment will give clearance to the concerned States/UTs on the first-come first-serve basis upto 20 awards for the country as a whole. The selected candidates will be provided a maintenance allowance at rates applicable to Group 'B' courses, i.e. Rs. 290 per month for hostlers and Rs. 190 per month for day scholars. In addition, all compulsory fees, including flight charges are to be provided in fee.

Note 2: M. Phil and Ph.D courses are post-graduation courses. Scholarship to such students may be paid at the rate of maintenance allowance for Group 'A', 'B' or 'C' depending on the course under these groups.

Note 3: Scholars who are entitled to free board and/or lodging will be paid maintenance charges at 1/3rd of Hostlers' rate.

ii) Reader Charges for blind students (Blind Scholars)

The blind scholars will be given additional amount as 'Reader Charges' as mentioned below:-

iii) Fees

Scholars will be paid enrolment /registration, tuition, games, Union, Library, Magazine, Medical examination and such other fees compulsorily payable by the scholar to the institution or University/Board. Refundable deposit-like caution money, security deposit will, however, be excluded.

iv) Study Tours:

Study tour charges upto a maximum of Rs. 500/- per annum limited to the actual expenditure incurred by the student on transportation charges etc., will be paid to the scholars studying professional and technical courses, provided that the head of the institution certifies that the study tour is essential for the scholar for completion of his/her course of study.

v) Thesis Typing /Printing charges

Thesis typing/printing charges upto a maximum of Rs. 600 will be paid to research scholars on the recommendation of the Head of the Institution.

V.

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

All the eligible Other Backward Classes candidates will be given scholarships subject to the condition of eligibility prescribed in para III of this Scheme. Candidates belonging to one State but studying in another State will be awarded scholarship by the State to which they belong and will submit their applications to the competent authorities in that State. In the matter of exemption from fees or other concessions also they will be treated as if they were studying in their own State.

VI

DURATION AND RENEWAL OF AWARDS

- i) the award once made will be tenable from the stage at which it is given to the completion of course subject to good conduct and regularity in attendance. It will be renewed from year provided that within a course which is continuous for a number of years, the scholar secures promotion to the next higher class irrespective of the fact whether such examinations are conducted by a University or the Institution.
- ii) If an OBC scholar pursuing Group A course fails in the examination for the first time, the award may be renewed. For second and subsequent failures in any class the student shall bear his/her own expenses until he/she secures promotion to the next higher class.
- iii) If a scholar is unable to appear in the annual examination owing to illness and or on account of any other unforeseeable event, the award may be renewed for the next academic year on submission of medical certificate and/or other required sufficient proof to the satisfaction of the Head of the Institution and his/her certifying that the scholar would have passed had he appeared in the examination.
- iv) If according to the Regulations of a University /Institution, a student is promoted to the next higher class even though he/she may not have actually passed in lower class and is required to take examination of the junior class again after sometime, he/she will be entitled to scholarship for the class to which he/she is promoted if the student is otherwise eligible for scholarship.

VII

PAYMENT

- i) Maintenance charges shall be payable from 1st April or from the month of admission, whichever is later, to the month in which the examination are completed at the end of the academic year.(including maintenance during holidays) provided that if the scholar secures admission after the 20th day of a month, the amount will be made from the month following the month of admission.
- ii) In case of renewal of scholarships awarded in the previous years, maintenance charges will be paid from the month following the month upto which scholarship was paid in the previous year, if the course of study is continuous (e.g., from intermediate jr. Intermediate, Sr.Class)
- iii) All scholars are expected to purchase the necessary text books, stationary etc., out of the maintenance allowance sanctioned. If it is reported by the Head of the concerned Institution that a scholar is without text-books stationary etc., the value of the scholarship may be reduced at the discretion of the authority sanctioning the scholarship.
- iv) The scholarship money will be paid to the selected students by the government of the State/Union Territory's Administration to which they belong in accordance with the procedure laid down by them in this regard.
- v) Scholarship will not be paid for the period of internship/houseman ship in the M.B.B.S. course or for a practical training in other course if the student is in receipt of some remuneration during the internship period or some allowance/stipend during the practical training in other course.

VIII

OTHER CONDITIONS FOR THE AWARD

- (i) The scholarship is dependent on the satisfactory progress and conduct of the scholars. If it is reported by the Head of the Institution at any time that a scholar has by reasons of his/her own act or default failed to make satisfactory progress or has been guilty of misconduct such as resorting to or participating in strikes, irregularity in attendance without the permission of the authorities concerned etc., the authority sanctioning the scholarships may either cancel the scholarships or stop or withhold further payment of such period as it may think fit.
- (ii) If a student is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statement his/her scholarship will be cancelled forthwith and the amount of the scholarship paid will be recovered, at the discretion of the concerned State Government. The student concerned will be blacklisted and debarred for scholarship in any Scheme for ever.
- (iii) A scholarship awarded may be cancelled if the scholar changes the subject of the course of study for which the scholarship were originally awarded or changes the institution of study, without prior approval of the State Government. The Head of the Institution shall report such cases to them and stop recovered at the discretion of the State Government.
- (iv) A scholar is liable to refund the scholarship amount at the discretion of the State Government, if during the course of the year, the studies for which the scholarship has been awarded, is discontinued by him/her.
- (v) The regulations can be changed at any time at the discretion of the Government of India.

IX

ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE SCHEME:

All the State Governments/UT Adms will announce in May-June, the details of the scheme and invite applications by issuing an advertisement in the leading newspapers of the State and through other media outfits. All requests for application forms and other particulars should be addressed to the concerned State/UT to which students actually belong. The applicant should submit the completed application to the prescribed authority before the last date prescribed for receipt of applications.

X

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:

- i) An application for scholarship should comprise:
 - (a) One copy of the application for scholarship in the prescribed form (separate application forms have been prescribed for 'fresh' and renewal scholarship).
 - (b) One copy of the passport size photograph with signatures of the student thereon (for fresh scholarship)
 - (c) One attested copy of certificates/diploma/degree etc., in respect of all examination passed
 - (d) A certificate (in original) of Caste signed by an authorized Revenue Officer now below the rank of Tehsildar.
 - (e) An income declaration by the parents/guardians, stating definite income from all sources
 - (f) A receipt in acknowledgement of the scholarship in the previous year on the form attached to the application only duly countersigned by the Head of the Institution concerned, if the applicant was in receipt of a scholarship under this Scheme in the preceding year.
- ii) Application complete in all respect shall be submitted to the Head of the Institution being attended or last attended by the candidates and shall be addressed to an officer specified for this purpose by the Government of State/Union Territory to which the student belong in accordance with the instructions issued by them from time to time.
- iii) Incomplete applications received after the prescribed date will not be consider.

XI

MONITORING:

The monitoring of the financial and physical performance of the scheme will be done through seeking detailed information from the Agencies implementing the Scheme. On the physical aspects the Agencies implementing the scheme will be required to furnish quarterly progress reports regarding the number of beneficiaries receiving award under the scheme, both class-wise and gender-wise. On the financial side details of actual expenditure incurred during the last financial year and expenditure proposed for the present financial year will be submitted by the Agencies concerned. The Agencies implementing the scheme will also be insisted upon to submit the latest audited accounts.

XII

EVALAUTION:

The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment may get the scheme evaluated by entrusting a research study to reputed institutions/agencies, on the performance of the scheme in different parts of the country, under this Ministry's central sponsored Scheme of Research and Training.

Read.—Government Resolution, Education and Social Welfare Department, No. BCP. 1059-E, dated 21st January 1960.

Government Resolution, Education and Social Welfare Department, No. EBC. 1066/54787-J, dated 29th August 1966.

RESOLUTION.—The question regarding revision of pattern of the scheme for award of free-studentship, examination fees and payment of pre-matric scholarships to the Scheduled Castes (including Nav-Budhas), Scheduled Tribes (including those outside specified areas), Vimukta Jatis, and Nomadic Tribes students sanctioned under Government Resolution, Education and Social Welfare Department, No. BCP. 1059-E, dated 21st January 1960, and Government Resolution, Education and Social Welfare Department, No. EBC-1066/54787-J, dated 29th August 1966, was considered by the Committee appointed under Government Resolution, Education and Social Welfare Department, No. EBC-1067/30339-J, dated 7th June 1967, to review these concessions. The Committee's Recommendations were considered by Government at length.

2. Revised Rules for Grant of Free-studentship and Examination Fees.—After careful consideration, Government is pleased to sanction the accompanying Revised Rules for grant of free-studentship (Appendix A) and Examination fee (Appendix B) to the students belonging to Scheduled Castes (including Nav-Budhas), Scheduled Tribes (including those outside the specified areas) declared under the Constitution (SC) Order, 1950 and The Constitution (ST) Order, 1950, so far as it relates to Maharashtra State, Vimukta Jatis and Nomadic Tribes which are declared as such by the State Government, studying in Educational Institutions and who or whose parents or guardians are ordinarily residents of Maharashtra State. The term 'ordinary residence' means those who are staying in Maharashtra for the period of 5 years. Consequently students from outside the State who join institution in the State temporarily with the object of completing their studies will not be eligible for these concessions.

3. Sets of Scholarship and Rules for sanctioning these Scholarships in Schools.—After utilising the provision made in the budget for meeting the expenditure towards grant of the above concessions of free-studentships and examination fees, the available funds should be utilised for grant of scholarships to the above category of students reading in Primary, Middle, Secondary Schools and Technical High Schools. The break up of the expenditure under the scheme of grant of free-studentships, Examination fees and Scholarships during 1968-69 was as follows:—

The information collected from the Social Welfare Officers revealed that the scholarships were awarded in some of the districts as they had sufficient allotment, while other Districts could get funds only to the extent of grant of free-studentships and examination fees and hence student of the above category could not be granted scholarships. Since expenditure of Rs. 7,85,000 is being incurred on grant of scholarships, it is possible to distribute this amount and grant sets of scholarships to the above category of students studying in primary, middle, secondary schools and technical high schools in all the districts, based on student population so that the scholarships are equitably distributed in all the districts. On the basis of the expenditure of Rs. 7,85,000 incurred on grant of scholarships to the above category of students during 1968-69, Government is pleased to sanction the sets of scholarships to the above category of students for the year 1970-71 as indicated in Appendix "E". The Director of Social Welfare should place the provision of the last column of Appendix "E" at the disposal of the concerned Social Welfare Officers every year.

4. The value of these scholarships and the category of the students to whom they should be awarded as below.

Standard III and IV	Rs. 3 per month.	
Middle School Standard V, VI, VII	Rs. 6 per Month.	For Scheduled Castes (including Nav-Budhas) Scheduled Tribes (including those outside specified areas).
High School Standard VIII, IX, X and XI	Rs. 10 per month.	Vimukta Jatis and Nomadic Tribes which are declared as such by State Government.
Tech. High School Standard VIII and IX	Rs. 30 per month.	
Tech. High School Standard X and XI	Rs. 40 per month.	

5. How the Scholarship is to be awarded. (a) Standard I to IV.—(i) From 1970-71, the Social Welfare Officers should invite applications through the Heads of institutions and sanction scholarships every year on merit-cum-means to students in Standard I to IV as per recommendations of the Heads of Institutions.—(ii) Government is pleased to sanction accompanying rules for the award of Primary Schools Scholarships (Appendix 'F')

(b) Standard V to XI during 1970-71.—The Social Welfare Officers should invite applications through the Heads of Institutions and sanction scholarships on merit-cum-means to students in Standard V to XI as per recommendations of the Heads of Institutions. The Scholarships once awarded to students in Standard V and above may continue till they complete the middle school course i.e. Standard VII. Similarly, the scholarship awarded to students in Standard VIII and above, may continue till they complete their High School career i.e. pass the S.S.C. Examination. The conditions of tenure of these scholarships are as indicated in paragraphs 10 and 11 of the accompanying rules for the award of these scholarships (Appendix 'C' and Appendix 'D').

6. Award of Scholarships to students who pass the Middle and High School Scholarship Examination in Standard V to XI from 1971.—(a) The Director of Publicity should be requested to issue a Press Note that all Scheduled Castes (including Nav-Budhas) and Scheduled Tribes (including those outside specified areas), Vimukta Jatis and Nomadic Tribes students reading in Std. IV and Std. VII should appear for Middle/High School Scholarships examination conducted by the Director of Education from 1970 onwards every year and that these scholarships will be awarded to those students of the above category who pass the Middle and High School scholarship examination in order of merit i.e. marks obtained in the examination. The Heads of the Institutions should bring to the notice of all the students of the above category about these examinations and get the names of students of the above category appearing for the said examinations and obtain the required number of forms from the President of the Examination Committee and supply these to the students and see that applications are sent in-time.

(b) The Scheduled Castes (including Nav-Budhas), Scheduled Tribes (including those outside specified areas), Vimukta Jatis and Nomadic Tribes students who get the scholarships on merit out of the sets of scholarships provided by State Government from the Education Department funds for each district will be awarded scholarship by the Director of Education, Poona from provision made by the Education Department as per rules sanctioned in Government Resolution, Education Department, No. SSG-1353, dated 2nd April 1954.

(c) The Director of Education, Poona, should furnish to the Director of Social Welfare a list of those Scheduled Castes (including Nav-Budhas), Scheduled Tribes (including those outside specified areas) Vimukta Jatis and Nomadic Tribes students who pass the above examinations by securing at least 45 per cent marks but could not secure merit students who passed the examination, their district and Taluka places where they are studying, marks obtained by them in the examination and the list should be arranged district-wise in order of merit i.e. marks obtained by these students in the above examination.

(d) The Director of Social Welfare, Poona, should then send these districtwise lists to the Social Welfare Officers of the District sanctioning scholarships to students of the above category as per sets allotted to the district and pay the required budget allotment at the disposal of the Social Welfare Officers.

(e) The Social Welfare Officers should then notify the sanction in the local newspapers and also communicate the sanction to the students concerned requesting them to report to him their permanent address, the name of the school they have joined and in what standard. On receipt of the details, the Social Welfare Officers should communicate the sanction to the Head of the School concerned.

(f) If the scholarship falls vacant for some reason or the other e.g. the student does not join the school etc. the Head of the Institution should inform the Social Welfare Officer concerned who should sanction scholarship to the next student in order of merit.

(g) If in any district there is not a sufficient number of students who have passed the said examination and in another district there are more students who have passed the said examination, the Director of Social Welfare, Poona, can divert these sets to the other district and report the action taken by him accordingly to Government.

(h) As far as possible the Head of the School should make payment of scholarship in kind e.g. books, stationery, books, compass, box, uniform and other Training material and should keep proper account of the material supplied studentwise. After deducting the cost of training material given to the students, the balance amount of scholarship should be paid to the student in the manner indicated in the rules for payment of these scholarships. Paragraph 11

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7. Government is pleased to sanction the accompanying rules for the award of Middle School scholarships (Appendix "C") and High School Scholarships (Appendix "D").

8. The expenditure on this account should be debited to the budget head "39-Misc-Social and Developmental Organisations—D-other Misc-Organisations-Schemes in the Five-Year Plan-D-X (i)-Backward Class Welfare etc." and met from the provision made thereunder.

1. Freestudentship.—Freestudentship covers: (1) Tuition fees (including tutorial fees), (2) Laboratory fees, (3) Admission fee, (4) Gymkhana fees, (5) Term fee, (6) Library fees.

2. Who are eligible for freestudentships.—All children of Scheduled Castes (including New Backward Classes) (including those outside specified areas) declared under the Constitution (SC) Order, 1950, and the Constitution (ST) Order, 1950, so far as it relates to Maharashtra State, Vimukta Jatis and Nomadic Tribes which are declared such by the State Government, and whose parents or guardians are ordinary residents of Maharashtra, irrespective of age and income, are eligible for this freestudentship at all stages of education and in all types of recognised institutions, except for courses of part-time nature such as Motor Driving and of short term duration, such as short-hand and type-writing, where tuition is only for three hours or less per day and also for courses for which there is no minimum educational qualification for admission. Full-time Tailoring course recognised by the Director of Technical Education should be held eligible for freestudentship.

The term "ordinary residence" means those who are staying in Maharashtra State for a period of five years. Consequently students from outside this State, who join educational institutions in this State, temporarily, with the object of completing their studies, are not eligible for award of freestudentship.

3. Application for freestudentship.—No student of the above category is required to make an application for award of freestudentship to any authority. The Head of the Institution shall forward detailed information about each student in a form prescribed to the authority sanctioning this concession of freestudentship (i.e. Social Welfare Officer of the concerned District).

4. Fees not to be charged.—(i) Fees shall not be charged in any Government and non-Government institution from any pupil eligible for studentship under these rules.
(ii) Non-Government institutions shall be paid a grant-in-aid equal to fees charged by the institutions as per procedure indicated in para 7 below.

5. Sanctioning Authority.—The authorities sanctioning the above concession are as follows:—

Nature of concessions	Sanctioning authority
(i) Tuition fees and examinations fees [to S. C./ S. T. Students] upto Pre-S. S. C.	Social Welfare Officer, Greater Bombay, so far as institutions in Greater Bombay are concerned and Social Welfare Officers of Zilla Parishads in the rest of the districts.
(ii) Tuition fees and examination fees to Backward Classes not in receipt of Government of India scholarship and not covered under Economically backward Class scheme for post-S. S. C. course.	The Social Welfare Officer, Greater Bombay in so far as Greater Bombay is concerned and the Director of Social Welfare, Maharashtra State, Poona, for remaining 25 districts.

The Backward Classes covered under the category of Economically Backward Classes are eligible for freeships under the Economically Backward Classes scheme through the respective Educational Officers of Zilla Parishads in the State and Educational Inspector, Greater Bombay so far as Greater Bombay is concerned.

6. Conditions for awards of freestudentship.—(i) This concession will not be awarded to students who fail twice in the same standard or class. Non-appearance at the examination shall be treated as a failure. On subsequent promotion to higher standard or class, he shall again become eligible for freestudentship.
(ii) Continuance of freestudentship shall be subject to the regular attendance, satisfactory progress, and good conduct.
(iii) Freestudentship shall not be awarded to a pupil for more than one course of instruction simultaneously. That means it is available for only one course of instructions at a time.

7. Procedure for reimbursement of fees.—Non-Government Educational Institutions awarding freestudentships under these rules shall send their bills for reimbursement for loss of fee income to the sanctioning authorities mentioned in para 5(i) above (i.e. Social Welfare Officer, Greater Bombay in case of the institutions situated in Greater Bombay and Social Welfare Officer, Zilla Parishads in rest of the districts) as indicated below:—

- (i) First instalment in September for preceding months of June, July and August.
- (ii) Second instalment in December for the preceding months of September, October and November.
- (iii) Third instalment in March for the preceding months of December, January and February.
- (iv) Fourth instalment in June for the preceding months of March, April and May.

In case of educational institutions where fees are charged termwise, bills shall be sent to the Social Welfare Officer

for a period preceding three years i.e. pending over three

Examination fees

1. All pupils from Scheduled Caste (including Nav-Budhas), Scheduled Tribes (including those outside specified areas) declared under Constitution (SC) Order, 1950, and the Constitution (ST) Order, 1950 so far as it relates to Maharashtra State, Vimukta Jatis and Nomadic Tribes, which are declared as such by State Government, irrespective of income and age, shall be granted examination fees for all examinations held by Government Universities, S. S. C. and other Boards or by other agencies and institutions recognised by Government. This concession shall not be granted to students who appear and fail more than once in the same examination.

2. Examination fees shall not be reimbursed in respect of courses of part-time nature e.g. Motor Driving, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Vimukta Jatis and Nomadic Tribes students appearing for the prescribed Government examination in type-writing and short-hand, tailoring, which are courses of short duration, shall be reimbursed the examination fees on passing the examination at the approved rate, provided they pass the examination at the first attempt.

3. Application for concession.—No students shall be required to make an application for concession of grant of examination fees to any authority. The Heads of Institutions shall forward detailed information about each student in a form prescribed by the Social Welfare Officer concerned who will sanction the fees and will countersign the bills preferred by the Heads of Institutions in this respect.

4. Claims for a period preceding three years i.e. pending over three years will not be considered without valid justification.

APPENDIX 'C'

C. Rules for the award of Middle School Scholarships to Scheduled Caste (including Nav-Budhas), Scheduled Tribes (including those outside the specified areas), Vimukta Jatis and Nomadic Tribes Students.

1. The student belonging to Scheduled Caste (including Nav-Budhas), Scheduled Tribes (including those outside specified areas) declared under the Constitution (SC) Order, 1950, the Constitution (ST) Order, 1950, so far as it relates to Maharashtra State, Vimukta Jatis and Nom. Tribes which are declared as such by State Government, appearing for and passing the Middle School Scholarship Examination conducted by the Director of Education, Poona, will be eligible for these scholarships.

2. Eligibility of candidates.—(a) The students of the above category from any institution recognised by the Department of Education will be allowed to compete the examination but no candidate who has not been a bona-fide pupil of one and the same school for a year i.e. from the beginning of the school year immediately preceding the examination, will be allowed to compete.

(b) In case of the bona-fide transfer or permanent change of residence of a parent or guardian of a pupil from one locality to another, the above condition may be relaxed at the discretion of the Educational Inspector, Greater Bombay, Education Officer, Zilla Parishad/Inspectress of Girls' Schools.

(c) In case of a pupil who has changed his/her school in consequence of higher standard not being taught in the former school, the Examination Committee formed by the Director of Education, can admit him/her to the examination provided that the break involved is not more than 20 days.

(d) All students of the above category, irrespective of their parent's income, will be eligible for competing the Middle School Scholarship Examination.

(e) No candidate above the age of 15 years on 1st of March immediately after the annual school examination held will be eligible for the Scholarships. That is, the age limit of 12 years should be relaxed upto 15 years in favour of students of the above category to be eligible for competing the examination.

(f) No candidate who attended or was studying in Standard V or a higher standard during the year in which the Scholarship Examination is to be held or in previous year, will be eligible to compete for the scholarship.

3. Application.—Application for permission to compete at the examination must be made through the Head Master of the school in which the candidate is studying to the President of the Scholarship Examination Committee formed by the Director of Education. Form in the prescribed form so as to reach him on or before the 5th day of the month preceding the month of examination.

The Head Masters of the schools should bring to the notice of all the students of the above category and who below 16 years of age about these examinations and get the names of students in the above category appearing for said examination and obtain the required number of forms from the President of the Examination Committee and supply these to the concerned students and see that the applications are sent in time.

4. Examination fees.—Candidates belonging to the above category are exempted from payment of examination fee of Rs. 1 (Rupee only).

5. The students who are not eligible to appear for the Middle School Scholarship Examination should apply to the Director of Education, Poona, for the purpose of getting their names included in the list of eligible candidates. The application should be submitted to the Director of Education, Poona from the 15th day of the month preceding the month of examination. The Director of Education, Poona will issue the list of eligible candidates to the concerned schools.

The Director of Education, Maharashtra, should send these district-wise lists to the Social Welfare Department at the disposal of the Social Welfare Officer.

7. The Director of Social Welfare, Poona, should then send these district-wise lists to the Social Welfare Officer of the district sanctioning scholarships to the students as per sets allotted to the district and place the sanction at the disposal of the Social Welfare Officer.

8. The Social Welfare Officer should then notify the sanction in local newspapers and also in the institution concerned. He should also report to him the name of the school they have chosen and the standard.

9. The payment of Scholarships—(a) The payment should be made by the Social Welfare Officer of the Zilla Parishad of the District concerned.

(b) The Social Welfare Officer after issue of necessary award of scholarships should draw the scholarship amount for the first nine months i.e. from July to March in advance and send the same to the Head of Institution in respect of all scholarship holders studying in the Institute.

(c) The Head of the Institutions should deposit the money in a Personal Deposit Account to be opened by him with the local Treasury/Sub-Treasury and draw the Scholarship in the first week of every month in advance for payment to the scholar.

(d) The Head of the Institution should send the details of accounts for the first six months to the Social Welfare Officer on receipt of which the Social Welfare Officer should draw the amount of Scholarship for the remaining three months i.e. from April to June in the month of March and send the Bank Drafts to the Heads of Institutions who should take action to deposit the Bank Draft in the Personal Ledger Account and make the payment of Scholarship amount in the first week of every month in advance to the scholar.

(e) The payment of scholarship should start from the month in which the admission is obtained. In the case of renewal of scholarship for the succeeding year, scholarship should be paid from the month following that from which it was obtained to Government.

10. Value and period of tenure of scholarship—(a) The Scholarships sanctioned by the Director of Social Welfare, Poona will be payable for three years in Standard V to VII in recognised schools.

(b) The value of the scholarship will be Rs. 6 per month.

(c) The students of the above category residing in hostels and who earn the above scholarships from Education Department or Social Welfare Department should be allowed scholarship at half the rate.

11. Conditions of tenure—(a) Successful candidates will be required to join Standard V of a recognised school in the month of February at the commencement of the next school year, and any scholar not joining such a school before the 1st of July following the examination, will be liable to forfeiture of the scholarship.

(b) Each scholarship will be tenable for three years from the commencement of the first terms succeeding the examination conditionally on the regular attendance, good conduct and satisfactory progress namely passing annual examination by securing at least 45 percent marks by the holder in a recognised school to be certified by the Head of the school.

(c) Failure to satisfy any of these conditions will render the scholar liable to the forfeiture of his scholarship by the Social Welfare Officer.

(d) Every scholar must be presented before the Government Inspecting Officer at the annual inspection of the school.

(e) The holder of a scholarship cannot change his/her school without the previous permission of the Head of the school.

(f) No scholar can hold, at the same time, any other Government scholarship or a scholarship from an endowment fund vested in Government without the permission of the Director of Social Welfare, Maharashtra State, Poona.

APPENDIX 'D'

Rules for the award of High School Scholarships to Scheduled Castes (including Non-Buddhist Scheduled Tribes) and Nomadic Tribes students. The Director of Education, Maharashtra, should send these district-wise lists to the Social Welfare Department at the disposal of the Social Welfare Officer. The Social Welfare Officer should then notify the sanction in local newspapers and also in the institution concerned. He should also report to him the name of the school they have chosen and the standard. The payment of Scholarships—(a) The payment should be made by the Social Welfare Officer of the Zilla Parishad of the District concerned. (b) The Social Welfare Officer after issue of necessary award of scholarships should draw the scholarship amount for the first nine months i.e. from July to March in advance and send the same to the Head of Institution in respect of all scholarship holders studying in the Institute. (c) The Head of the Institutions should deposit the money in a Personal Deposit Account to be opened by him with the local Treasury/Sub-Treasury and draw the Scholarship in the first week of every month in advance for payment to the scholar. (d) The Head of the Institution should send the details of accounts for the first six months to the Social Welfare Officer on receipt of which the Social Welfare Officer should draw the amount of Scholarship for the remaining three months i.e. from April to June in the month of March and send the Bank Drafts to the Heads of Institutions who should take action to deposit the Bank Draft in the Personal Ledger Account and make the payment of Scholarship amount in the first week of every month in advance to the scholar. (e) The payment of scholarship should start from the month in which the admission is obtained. In the case of renewal of scholarship for the succeeding year, scholarship should be paid from the month following that from which it was obtained to Government. 10. Value and period of tenure of scholarship—(a) The Scholarships sanctioned by the Director of Social Welfare, Poona will be payable for three years in Standard V to VII in recognised schools. (b) The value of the scholarship will be Rs. 6 per month. (c) The students of the above category residing in hostels and who earn the above scholarships from Education Department or Social Welfare Department should be allowed scholarship at half the rate. 11. Conditions of tenure—(a) Successful candidates will be required to join Standard V of a recognised school in the month of February at the commencement of the next school year, and any scholar not joining such a school before the 1st of July following the examination, will be liable to forfeiture of the scholarship. (b) Each scholarship will be tenable for three years from the commencement of the first terms succeeding the examination conditionally on the regular attendance, good conduct and satisfactory progress namely passing annual examination by securing at least 45 percent marks by the holder in a recognised school to be certified by the Head of the school. (c) Failure to satisfy any of these conditions will render the scholar liable to the forfeiture of his scholarship by the Social Welfare Officer. (d) Every scholar must be presented before the Government Inspecting Officer at the annual inspection of the school. (e) The holder of a scholarship cannot change his/her school without the previous permission of the Head of the school. (f) No scholar can hold, at the same time, any other Government scholarship or a scholarship from an endowment fund vested in Government without the permission of the Director of Social Welfare, Maharashtra State, Poona.

6. The Director of Education should submit to the Director of Social Welfare, list of names of the students of the category above mentioned who are eligible for the award of scholarships from the funds sanctioned by the Government of Maharashtra, Poona. This list should indicate the names of students of the above category who passed the examination securing at least 45 per cent marks, their District and Taluk, where they are studying and marks obtained in the above examination.

7. The Director of Social Welfare, Poona should then send these district-wise lists to the Social Welfare Officer of the district sanctioning scholarships to the students as per sets allotted to the district and place the required budget allotment at the disposal of the Social Welfare Officer.

8. The Social Welfare Officer should then notify the sanction in the local newspapers and also communicate to the students concerned requesting them to report to him the name of the school they have joined and in what standard.

9. *The payment of Scholarships.*—(a) The payment should be made by the Social Welfare Officer of the Zilla Parishad of the District concerned.

(b) The Social Welfare Officer after issue of necessary award of scholarships should draw the scholarship amount from the Government of Maharashtra from July to March in advance and send the same to the Head of Institution in respect of all scholarship holders studying in the Institute.

(c) The Head of the Institutions should deposit the money in a Personal Deposit Account to be opened by him with the local Treasury/Sub-Treasury and draw the Scholarship in the first week of every month in advance for payment to the scholar.

(d) The Head of the Institution should send the details of accounts for the first six months to the Social Welfare Officer on receipt of which, the Social Welfare Officer should draw the amount of Scholarship for the remaining three months i.e. from April to June in the month of March and send the Bank Drafts to the Head of Institutions who should be required to deposit the Bank Draft in the Personal Budget Account and make the payment of Scholarship in the first week of every month in advance to the scholar.

(e) The payment of scholarship should start from the month in which the admission is obtained. In the case of non-payment of scholarship for the succeeding year, scholarship should be paid from the month following that from which the Director of Social Welfare, Poona can divert these sets to the other district and reports the action taken by him to the Government.

10. *Value and period of tenure of scholarship.*—(a) The Scholarships sanctioned by the Director of Social Welfare, Poona will be tenable for three years in Standard V, VI, VII in recognised schools.

(b) The value of the scholarship will be Rs. 6 per month.

(c) The students of the above category residing in hostels and who earn the above scholarships from Education Department or Social Welfare Department should be allowed scholarship at half the rate.

11. *Conditions of tenure.*—(a) Successful candidates will be required to join Standard V of a recognised school in the month of April for the commencement of the next school year, and any scholar not joining such a school before the 1st of July following the examination will be liable to forfeiture of the scholarship.

(b) Each scholarship will be tenable for three years from the commencement of the first terms succeeding the examination conditionally on the regular attendance, good conduct and satisfactory progress, namely passing annual examination by securing at least 45 per cent marks by the holder in a recognised school to be certified by the Head of the school.

(c) Failure to satisfy any of these conditions will render the scholar liable to the forfeiture of his scholarship by the Social Welfare Officer.

(d) Every scholar must be presented before the Government Inspecting Officer at the annual inspection of the school.

(e) The holder of a scholarship cannot change his/her school without the previous permission of the Head of the school.

(f) No scholar can hold, at the same time, any other Government scholarship or a scholarship from an endowment fund vested in Government without the permission of the Director of Social Welfare, Maharashtra State, Poona.

APPENDIX 'D'

Rules for the award of High School Scholarships to Scheduled Castes (including Nav-Buddhas), Scheduled Tribes (including those outside specified areas) Vimukta Jatis and Nomadic Tribes students.

The students belonging Scheduled Castes (including Nav-Buddhas), Scheduled Tribes (including those outside specified areas) declared under the Constitution (SC) Order, 1950 and the Constitution (ST) Order, 1950 so far as in Maharashtra State, Vimukta Jatis, Nomadic Tribes which are declared as such by the State Government, are eligible for High School Scholarship Examination conducted by the Director of Education, Maharashtra State.

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2. *Eligibility of candidates.*—(a) The students of the above category from any institution recognised by the Government of Education will be allowed to compete the examination but no candidate who has not been a bona fide student of one and the same school for a year i.e. from the beginning of the school year immediately preceding the examination will be allowed to compete.

(b) In case of the bonafide transfer or permanent change of residence of a parent or guardian of a pupil from one locality to another the above condition may be relaxed at the discretion of the Educational Inspector, Greater Bombay Education Officer, Zilla Parishad/Inspectress of Girls Schools.

(c) In case of a pupil who has changed his/her school in consequence of higher standards not being taught in former schools, the Examination Committee formed by the Director of Education, can admit him/her to the examination provided that the break involved is not more than 20 days.

(d) All students of the above category irrespective of their parent's income will be eligible for competing in High School Scholarships examinations.

(e) No candidate above the age of 18 years on 1st of March immediately after the annual school examination is held, will be eligible for the scholarship. That is, the age limit of 15 years should be relaxed up to 18 years in favour of students of the above category to be eligible for competing the examination.

(f) No candidate who attended or was studying in Standard VIII or a higher standard during the year in which the scholarship examination is to be held, or in previous year will be eligible to compete for the scholarship.

3. *Application.*—Application for permission to compete at the examination must be made through the Head Master of the School in which candidate is studying, to the President of the Scholarship Examination Committee formed by the Director of Education, Poona, in the prescribed form so as to reach him on or before the 5th day of the month preceding the month of examination.

The Head Masters of the Schools should bring to the notice of all the students of the above category below the age of 18 years about these examinations and get the names of students of the above category appearing for the said examination and obtain the required number of forms from the President of the Examination Committee and supply these to the concerned students and see that the applications are sent in time.

4. *Examination fees.*—Candidates belonging to the above category are exempted from payment of examination fee of Re. 1 (Rupee one).

5. The students of the above category who appear and pass the High School Scholarship examination conducted by the Directorate of Education and get scholarship on merit out of the sets of Scholarships provided by the Education Department will be awarded scholarship by the Director of Education, Poona from the Education Department Budget as per rules sanctioned in Government Resolution, Education Department, No. SSG-1353, dated 2nd April, 1954, as revised from time to time. The students who do not secure scholarships on merit from the Directorate of Education will be awarded Scholarships by the Directorate of Social Welfare from the Social Welfare Funds on merit i.e. marks obtained in the examination. To be eligible for these scholarships from the Social Welfare Directorate, the student must secure at least 45 percent marks.

The Director of Education should furnish to the Director of Social Welfare a list of those students of the above category who pass the above examinations by securing at least 45 per cent marks but could not secure merit scholarship from out of sets sanctioned by the Director of Education, Poona. This list should indicate the names of students of the above category who passed the examination, their school, District and Taluka place where they are studying and marks obtained by them in the Examination. The list should be arranged districtwise and in order of merit i.e. marks obtained in the above examination.

7. The Director of Social Welfare, Poona should then send those districtwise lists to the Social Welfare Officer of the District sanctioning scholarships to the students as per sets allotted to the District and place the required budget allotment at the disposal of the Social Welfare Officer.

8. The Social Welfare Officer should then notify the sanction in the local news papers and also communicate the sanction to the students concerned requesting them to report to him their permanent address, the name of the school they have joined and in what standard. On receipt of the details, the Social Welfare Officer should communicate the sanction to the Head of the School concerned.

9. *Payment of scholarships.*—(a) Each scholarship will be tenable for four years from the commencement of the first term conditionally on regular attendance, good conduct and satisfactory progress viz. passing the annual examination by securing 50 per cent marks by the holder in a recognised school to be certified by the Head of Schools.

(b) Failure to satisfy any of these conditions will render the scholar liable to the forfeiture of his scholarship by the Social Welfare Officer.

(c) Every scholar must be presented before Government Inspecting Officer at the Annual inspection of the schools.

(d) The holder of a scholarship cannot change his/her school without previous permission of Head of the school.

(e) No scholar can hold at the same time, any other Government scholarship or a scholarship from an Educational Institution in Government without the permission of Director of Social Welfare, Maharashtra State, Poona.

(f) If the scholar dies or falls vacant for some reason or other e.g. the student does not join the school, etc. the Head of the School should inform the Social Welfare Officer concerned who will sanction the scholarship to the next eligible candidate. If the holder dies or falls vacant for some reason or other e.g. the student does not join the school, etc. the Head of the School should inform the Social Welfare Officer concerned who will sanction the scholarship to the next eligible candidate. If the holder dies or falls vacant for some reason or other e.g. the student does not join the school, etc. the Head of the School should inform the Social Welfare Officer concerned who will sanction the scholarship to the next eligible candidate.

(2) As far as possible the Head of the School should make payment of scholarships in kind for uniforms and other training material and should keep proper account of the material. After deducting the cost of training material given to the students, the balance amount of scholarship left should be paid to the students in the manner indicated above.

10. *Value and tenure of Scholarship.*—(a) The scholarship sanctioned will be tenable for four years in Standards VIII to XI in recognised secondary schools including Agricultural and Commercial High Schools.

(b) The value of the scholarship will be as under:—

Secondary Schools Standards— VIII to IX	Rs. 10 p. m.
Technical High Schools.—Standards VIII and IX	30 p. m.
Standard X to XI	40 p. m.

(c) The students of the above category residing in hostels and who earn the above scholarships from Education Department or Social Welfare Department should be allowed scholarship at half the rate.

11. *Conditions of tenure.*—(a) Successful candidates will be required to join Standard VIII of any of the recognised secondary schools including Agricultural, Technical or Commercial High Schools at the commencement of the next school year and any scholar not joining such a school before the 1st of July following the examination will be liable to forfeiture of the scholarships.

(b) Each scholarship will be tenable for four years from the commencement of the first term succeeding the examination conditionally on the regular attendance, good conduct and satisfactory progress viz. passing the annual examination by securing at least 45 per cent. marks by the holder in recognised school to be certified by the Head of the school.

(c) Failure to satisfy any of these conditions will render the scholar liable to the forfeiture of his scholarship by the Social Welfare Officer.

(d) Every scholar must be presented before the Government Inspecting Officer at the annual inspection of the school.

(e) The holder of scholarship cannot change his/her school without the previous permission of the Head of the School.

(f) No scholar can hold at the same time any other Government scholarship or a scholarship from an endowment fund vested in Government without the permission of the Director of Social Welfare, Maharashtra State, Poona.

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under the control of Primary School Scholarships to Scheduled Tribes (Including those outside the Special Areas) Order, 1957, in force in India, Part III of the Schedule to the Constitution.

The students belonging to Scheduled Tribes (including those outside the special areas) and who under the Constitution (S.T.) Order, 1957, are included in the list of Scheduled Tribes, who are recognised as such by State Government, and who are admitted to any Institution recognised by the Department of Education and who are bonafide pupils of such school for an academic year from the beginning till the end of the school year, will be eligible for these scholarships irrespective of their parents' income.

2. In case of the bonafide transfer or permanent change of residence of a parent or guardian of a pupil from one locality to another the above condition may be relaxed at the discretion of the Social Welfare Officer.

3. The Social Welfare Officer should invite applications through the Heads of Institutions and sanction scholarships every year on merit-means to students in Standard I to IV as per recommendations of the Heads of Institution.

4. *Value and Tenure of Scholarships.*—(a) The Scholarship sanctioned by Social Welfare Officer will be tenable for four years in Standard I to IV in recognised Primary Schools.

(b) The value of the Scholarship will be as under—

Primary School, Standard I and II	Rs. 2 per month.
Standard III and IV	Rs. 3 per month.

(c) *Condition of tenure.*—(i) Each Scholarship will be tenable for four years from the commencement of the first term conditionally on regular attendance, good conduct and satisfactory progress viz. passing the annual examination by securing 45 per cent marks by the holder in such recognised school to be certified by the Head of School.

(ii) Failure to satisfy any of these conditions will render the scholar liable to the forfeiture of his scholarship by Social Welfare Officer.

(iii) Every scholar must be presented before Government Inspecting Officer at the annual inspection of the School.

(iv) The holder of a Scholarship cannot change his (or her) school without previous permission of Head of the School.

(v) No Scholar can hold at the same time, any other Government Scholarship or a scholarship from an Endowment Fund vested in Government without the permission of Director of Social Welfare, M.S., Poona.

5. *Payment of scholarship.*—(a) The payment should be made by the Social Welfare Officer of the Zilla Parishads of the District concerned.

(b) The Social Welfare Officer after issue of necessary award of scholarships should draw the scholarship amount for the first nine months i.e. from July to March in advance and send the same to the Head of Institution in respect of all Scholarship holder studying in his Institute.

(c) The Head of the Institution should deposit the money in a Personal Deposit Account to be opened by him with the local Treasury/Post-Office and draw the scholarship in the first week of every month in advance for payment to the Scholar.

(d) The Head of Institution should send the details of accounts for the first six months to the Social Welfare Officers on receipt of which the S.W.O. should draw the amount of Scholarship for the remaining three months i.e. from April to June in the month of March and send the Bank Draft to the Head of Institution who should take action to deposit the Bank Draft in the Personal Ledger Account and make payment of Scholarship amount in the first week of every month in advance to the Scholar.

(e) The payment of scholarship should start from the month in which the admission is certified in the case of renewal of Scholarship or the succeeding year, scholarship should be paid from the month following that from which the scholarship was paid during the previous academic year if the course of study pursued is continuous.

6. If the Scholarship falls vacant for some reason or other e.g. the student does not join the school, etc. the Head of the School should inform the S.W.O. concerned who will sanction the Scholarship to the next student in list, in order of merit and then above procedure of payment of Scholarship be followed.

7. As far as possible the Head of the School should make payment of scholarships in kind e.g. books, notebooks, compass box, uniform and other training material and should keep proper account of the material supplied studentwise. After deducting the cost of training material given to the student, the balance amount of scholarship left should be paid to the student in the manner indicated above.
